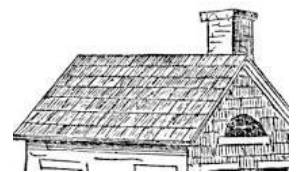
**Garden Planting Night** – Tuesday, **May 22, 2018** at 6:30 p.m. (Rain Night is May 23)

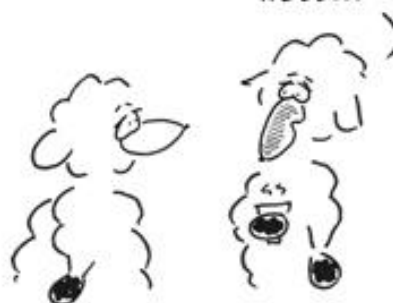
